It is a pleasure to officially welcome your company as a participant in the Universal Product Code (UPC) program.

Your company membership in the Uniform Code Council (UCC) in concert with many others brings increasing representation from a wide cross section of the food, drug and general merchandise industries in the United States, Canada and abroad.

The UPC manufacturer identification number and number system character assigned to your company are shown above. Because this letter documents your company's membership in the UCC, it should be preserved and made a matter of permanent record.

Now that you have received your unique 5 digit UPC manufacturer identification number, your next step is to assign a 5 digit item number to each different product in your line. These numbers can be assigned in any manner you choose; however, the number must be 5 digits and each item must carry a different 5 digit item number. This item number, used in conjunction with your first 5 digits and number system character assigned by the Code Council, will yield your 11 digit UPC Code.
